We have grown from a Saturday Concert in Shipley Church with a Jazz evening at the Selsey Arms to the leading Classical Music Festival in Sussex. We have commissioned composers to create a legacy to the backdrop of Sussex which has rekindled the musical creativity of the twentieth century established by Vaughan Williams, John Ireland, Sir Edward Elgar, Frank Bridge and George Butterworth. Please see the list of works we have commissioned* and this year, we also look forward to a violin Concerto written by Sussex composer Paul Lewis to be performed on our Stradivarius violin. We are unique in the UK and an example to the world. Our community comprises very special sponsors who support the Arts as Patrons and share in our work of bringing together communities.
